Math: Next week is our second week on the subtraction table of 6. That means that the subtraction tables of 0-6 should be mastered by Thursday! That means that the children are able to do 66 problems in 3 minutes with 2 or less mistakes! Please help your child memorize the bigger problems like: $15-6=9$, $13-6=7$, $14-6=8$, $16-6=10$, $14-5=9$, $12-5=7$, $12-8=4$.
